How to Use The Plugin

1. Installing the Plugin to Your WP Website

- Navigate to Plugins menu -> Add New
- Click the “Upload Plugin” button
- Select wtp-import-ytube.zip file from your storage
- Click the “Install Now” button

After the plugin is installed, then you can activate the plugin.

2. Import Youtube Video to Your WP Website

- Navigate to WTP Tools menu -> Import YTube submenu
- Enter the Youtube video ID on the available text field
- Click the “Import Video” button

Wait a few seconds, then the video will be imported as WP content.

You can view the content from Posts menu -> All Posts.

By default, the content is set to “Draft”.

That way you can edit the content before publishing it.

Common Questions & Troubleshooting

* How to find the Youtube video ID?

Example, the video link is this:

<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=GlwEnk3Wq2I>

Then the video ID will be GlwEnk3Wq2I

* How to change the video width/height on the content?

The video width/height is defined by the theme that your website is using. It is recommended to ask the theme creator on how to do that.

* When importing the video, I get a “cURL error”?

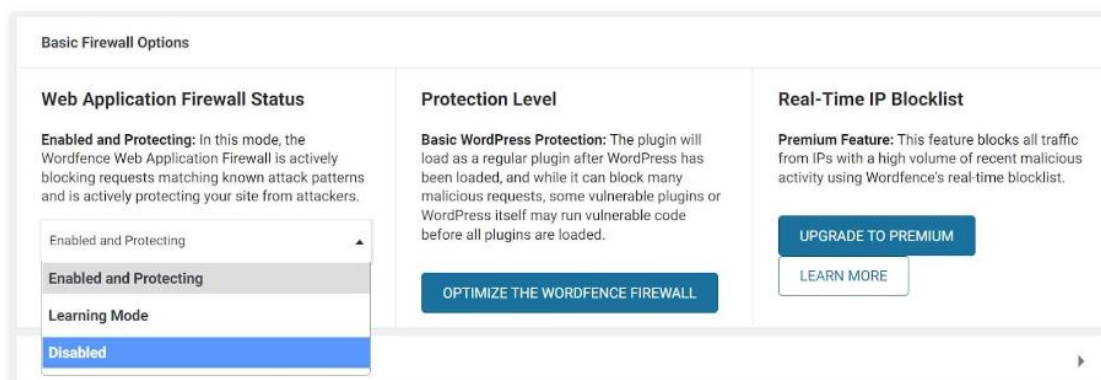
It commonly happens due to these two conditions:

- 1.) Security plugin on your website blocks the WP Rest API request.
- 2.) Your website is using CloudFlare (DNS, SSL, etc.)

If you suspect the issue is because security plugins, then you may try to disable the plugin temporary and try to import the video again.

If your website is using Wordfence, try to disable the Firewall setting:

- In your WordPress dashboard, head to Wordfence > Firewall. Then scroll down to Web Application Firewall Status:
- Select Disabled from the dropdown menu and click on Save Changes.



If your website is using CloudFlare (DNS, SSL, etc.), the only good solution I have found so far is to pause CloudFlare:

CloudFlare blocking WP Rest API is a common problems in WP community.

However I have ever used CloudFlare at all, so pausing CloudFlare is the only solution I can suggest based on cases from other users.
